# about the hospice

The Prince of Wales Hospice is based in Pontefract but provides care free-of-charge to people across a wide area of West Yorkshire. Our in-patient unit, day-care centre and lymphoedema clinic support people with any life limiting illness, as well as their family and carers.



We work together with other health and social care professionals to help people as soon as their illness is diagnosed as terminal, or life-limiting. At this distressing time we offer expert emotional and psychological support, or even just a listening ear. Our active day-care centre is a source of social activity, therapy and expert medical care from a multi-professional team.

When the time is right we can accommodate people for 24 hour care, to help them manage their symptoms or for care at the end of their illness. Throughout, we are there for carers and families too, from help with practical arrangements, to respite, relaxation and counselling.



People are sometimes surprised to hear that we only receive about a third of our funding from the government. It is only because individuals, groups and companies from our local community care together with us that we can continue making a difference.
